COVID-19 SYMPTOMS

To keep the school community safe this is just a reminder for you.

If your child or a member of your household is unwell with symptoms of Covid-19, please do not use the Lateral Flow Tests you need to book a PCR test and the whole household must isolate until you have the results.

Please inform school either by phoning the school office or sending an email to

Covid -19 Symptoms

The most important symptoms of COVID-19 are recent onset of any of the following:

- a new continuous cough
- a high temperature
- a loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell (anosmia)

There are several other symptoms linked with COVID-19. These other symptoms may have another cause and are not on their own a reason to have a COVID-19 test. If you are concerned about your symptoms, please seek medical advice.

If your child has a positive test result please email school immediately, even out of school hours as we will need to contact anyone who has been a 'close contact'.

REMINDER: **SCHOOL DINNERS &** **PACKED LUNCHES**



If your child would like a school dinner, you must order on myevolvehub.com by 10am

We cannot order dinners in school!

You may pre-order dinners in advance per half-term. If your child will be absent after the order has been placed, you must cancel this by 10am on your account, or you will be still be charged as the order will already be with the kitchen. Dinners are priced at £2.30 per day.

If you forget to order a dinner, your child will receive a jacket potato with cheese and fresh fruit and in KS2 you will be charged £2.30 for this on your account. KS1 children are currently entitled to a universal free school meal. If you prefer, your child may bring a 'healthy' packed lunch to school – we **do not** allow hot items, i.e. soup.

UNIFORM DONATIONS

We would be very grateful if you have any good condition school jumpers/cardigans you no longer need and would like to donate to school for spare clothing. Please wash, remove any name labels and send into the school office. Many thanks.

PLEASE HELP TO KEEP EVERYONE SAFE AND REMEMBER TO:

- socially distance when collecting/picking up your child from school
- only 1 adult from the same household to collect/pick up
- pick up/collect at the correct time (do not arrive too early or late and use the one-way system)
- park away from school to keep the roads and paths clear
- wear a face covering
- remind children to wash/sanitise hands frequently
