**COVID-19 TESTING**

Advice from Wigan Local Authority and the Health Protection Team.

Please keep your child at home if they have;

- A new continuous cough
- A temperature
- A loss or change of taste/smell

Arrange for your child to have a PCR test (not just the Lateral flow test as this isn't always accurate). This can be arranged online [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk) or by telephoning 119. Isolate the household for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or until you receive a negative result.

If another member of the household is awaiting test results please keep your child at home until a negative result is received.

If your child has been in contact with a confirmed positive case, isolate for 10 days and it is recommended that you arrange a PCR test.

Inform the school office immediately if you receive a POSITIVE result [enquiries@admin.christchurch.wigan.sch.uk](mailto:enquiries@admin.christchurch.wigan.sch.uk)

Test results are usually received within 24 hours however postal test kits may take a few days. If this is negative then your child may return to school straight away if they are well and no longer have any symptoms.
