COVID-19 TESTING

Advice from Wigan Local Authority and the Health Protection Team.

Please keep your child at home if they have;

- A new continuous cough
- A temperature
- A loss or change of taste/smell

Arrange for your child to have a PCR test (not just the Lateral flow test as this isn't always accurate). This can be arranged online www.gov.uk or by telephoning 119. Isolate the household for 10 days from the onset of symptoms or until you receive a negative result.

If another member of the household is awaiting test results please keep your child at home until a negative result is received.

If your child has been in contact with a confirmed positive case, isolate for 10 days and it is recommended that you arrange a PCR test.

Inform the school office immediately if you receive a POSITIVE result enquiries@admin.christchurch.wigan.sch.uk

Test results are usually received within 24 hours however postal test kits may take a few days. If this is negative then your child may return to school straight away if they are well and no longer have any symptoms.



AUTUMN TERM 2021

Following on from the latest Government and Local Authority guidance, our aim is to return to some form of normality in September. For all children, our school times will return to 8:45 registration (the doors will open from 8:40) and pick up time will be 3:15. The new class teachers will be in contact with you to let you know which doors your child will use to enter/exit the building. Parents will be allowed to enter the playground to drop off/collect children. We do not intend to have bubbles from September but we may have some minimal restrictions in place depending on the risk assessment when it is completed. However, in certain circumstances such as a local outbreak, measures may need to be reintroduced. The building work will still be ongoing, so we request parents continue to park away from school and walk to ensure the safety of the school community.
